Current Crohn’s disease medications often cause unwanted side effects. Now, local doctors are hoping to determine if the investigational medication in this study can effectively treat Crohn’s disease with fewer side effects than current medications.

you must:**

- Be 18–80 years of age,
- Have been diagnosed with moderate to severe Crohn’s disease at least six months before study enrollment, AND
- Not have adequate relief of your symptoms with current or past Crohn’s disease treatments.

Qualified participants will receive study medication and study-related medical evaluations at no cost.


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
