



# Treating your Crohn's disease doesn't have to be a solo act.

#### Do you have Crohn's disease?

You may be eligible to participate in the ANDANTE study—a clinical research study evaluating whether an investigational drug (study drug) safely and effectively treats Crohn's disease compared to placebo (looks like the study drug but does not contain any active medication).

The study drug is designed to fight inflammation by working directly on the immune system. The ANDANTE study will also evaluate the best dose of the study drug for treating Crohn's disease.

#### You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are between 18 and 75 years old
- Have active Crohn's disease
- Have failed to respond to anti-TNF treatments (e.g., infliximab [Remicade<sup>®</sup>], adalimumab [Humira<sup>®</sup>], certolizumab pegol [Cimzia<sup>®</sup>])

Participation in the study is voluntary.
